### 4. Comments on delivery of each project

### a. Overall comments on project progress:

2017/18 saw another successful year for RiverConnect with notable achievements including the completion, adoption and the launch of the 2017 Strategic Plan at the Goulburn River; almost 5000 people involved in 132 community engagement activities; almost 2000 school students learnt about the River environment; 24 partnerships were maintained and developed; and RiverConnect featured in 14 media items.

Weed control, revegetation, engagement events, partnerships and community group targets were all exceeded.

#### b. Key achievements and highlights:

- RiverConnect Strategic Plan launched on 20 March 2018 at Boulevard Bush Reserve
- Grant received from Sustainability Victoria to campaign against Illegal Dumping of Rubbish
- Establishment of Illegal Dumping Working Group to bring relevant agencies together to reduce illegal dumping of rubbish in the river environments. Tasks include implementing the Sustainability Victoria project, running media campaign at strategic times of the year.
- Hosted 132 engagement events and activities for community, with a total of 4978 participants.
- Engaged with 1495 School students from 28 schools in 67 sessions/events
- RiverConnect has re-engaged the Academy of Sport Health Education (ASHE) indigenous students to complete their VCAL classes at The Flats
- The IAC reconnected with the Education Department and DELWP
- \$610,740 funding received from Regional Jobs and Investment Packages, through the Department of Industry, innovation and Science, for Shared Paths route 3's (The Flats) and 5 (Australian Botanic Gardens link). This will commence the implementation of the RiverConnect Shared Paths Masterplan.
- Agreement developed and signed by artist and Council granting use of Possum Cloak design on RiverConnect signage within the riverine environment.
- Partnership approach connected the GV Mountain Bike Club with Parks Victoria to begin discussions around formalizing some informal tracks within the Shepparton Regional Park.

### c. Challenges and issues faced that have directly impacted on project delivery in the reporting period:

- 1. Staff changes Project Officer resigned at the end of April. Recruitment has commenced, however no suitable candidate was found initially, therefore this position has been re-advertised.
- Finalisation of assets register of council assets on Parks Victoria managed land remains an on-going activity that has hindered the progress of proposed projects which are located on Parks Victoria managed land.

3. As noted in the 6 monthly report, the relationships with local Aboriginal Organisations have continued to improve, however the loss of the Project Officer has potentially slowed this momentum for the time being.

### d. How these challenges and/or issues are going to be mitigated or addressed:

- The Education Officer has increased her hours to full time (previously a 0.8EFT) in order to fill some of
  this gap. The outgoing Project Officer was able to leave comprehensive handover notes and provide
  directions on what needs to be followed up which has assisted the Education Officer in prioritising
  actions. The Education Officer is also receiving support from other staff members at Council.
- 2. Partners continue to engage in good faith to ensure this issue does not damage partner relationships.
- 3. Recruitment of a Project Officer with knowledge working with Traditional Owner Groups.

# f. A statement about the Project's approach for, and progress towards, supporting aboriginal engagement and collaboration:

- RiverConnect Project Officer has worked to ensure there is Aboriginal Elder representation on all
  committees and working groups where required and possible. This includes engagement of new
  representatives and re-engagement of current representatives from Yorta Yorta Nation Aboriginal
  Corporation and Rumbalara Aboriginal Corporation. There had been some great progress in regular
  attendance to IAC and working groups.
- RiverConnect increased engagement with Kaiela Arts during this reporting period, partnering to run
  community activities relating to Indigenous Arts, employing Indigenous Artists to facilitate workshops.
  The Education Program has also engaged artists from Kaiela Arts for its Primary School Environment
  Education Days, providing opportunities for cultural education through art.
- An agreement was signed between the artist of the Possum Cloak Design and Greater Shepparton City Council. This art design features on signage on the Flats and at Boulevard Bush Reserve and will be used on all signage within the riverine environment.
