

## **Recommendations from Jim Castles, GBCMA re the design of squirrel glider nesting boxes**

The most important thing is the size of the hole. It has to be between 40 and 44mm diameter apparently if they are to be used for Squirrel Gliders or Phascogales.

The internal measurement of the box are 180mm 180mm x 250mm high at the front and 295mm high at the back. There is a baffle inside (see the image attached) that is 150mm x 150mm. This sits across the entrance hole on the inside at 45 degrees.

This one has the hole in the back (perfect for a small diameter tree) but you can also put them in the side of the box to suit flat surfaces of larger diameter trees.
